LAST CHANCE FOR 2024 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

The 100th day of the 2024 lowa legislative session is April 16th, which is when the per diem expenses for legislators end. Although the legislature can continue to meet after the 16th, this is an incentive to wrap up their work.

The bill regarding the AEAs and teacher salaries has garnered a lot of attention, but it does not really directly affect the adults served at Empowering Abilities. The following bills may be of interest to adults with disabilities and their advocates:

WORK WITHOUT WORRY

This bill is designed to allow those people who are working and have a disability to not have to worry about how much they make in order to remain eligible for Medicaid benefits. Often, workers must cut back on their hours in order to remain eligible. At this point in the session, the bill has somewhat stalled out, although it isn't dead. It will need to move quickly if anything is to happen to it during the current session.

ABLE SAVINGS BILL

Achieving a Better Life Experience or ABLE accounts are tax-free savings accounts for people with disabilities that allows them to save money without losing their benefits. Anyone can contribute to the accounts and receive a tax deduction of up to \$4028. This bill would increase that amount to \$5500. More can be contributed, but only \$5500 can be deducted. The bill is still being considered by both chambers.

BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SYSTEM

This bill creates a new behavioral health and disabilities service system. There are many pieces to this bill; however, it does not affect most individuals at Empowering Abilities. Only a small number of participants rely on county funding, which is the focus of this bill.


