#1 Speak directly to the person rather than their companion or sign language interpreter.



#2 Always offer to shake hands when introduced.



#3 Always identify yourself and others when meeting someone who is blind.



#4 If you offer assistance, wait for an answer, then wait for instructions.



#5 Treat adults as adults.



#6 Do not lean against, or put your hand on a wheelchair or cart.



#7 Listen attentively to people with speech difficulties.



#8 Place yourself at eye level when speaking to someone in a wheelchair or crutches.



#9 Tap someone who is deaf on the shoulder to get their attention



#10 Relax
